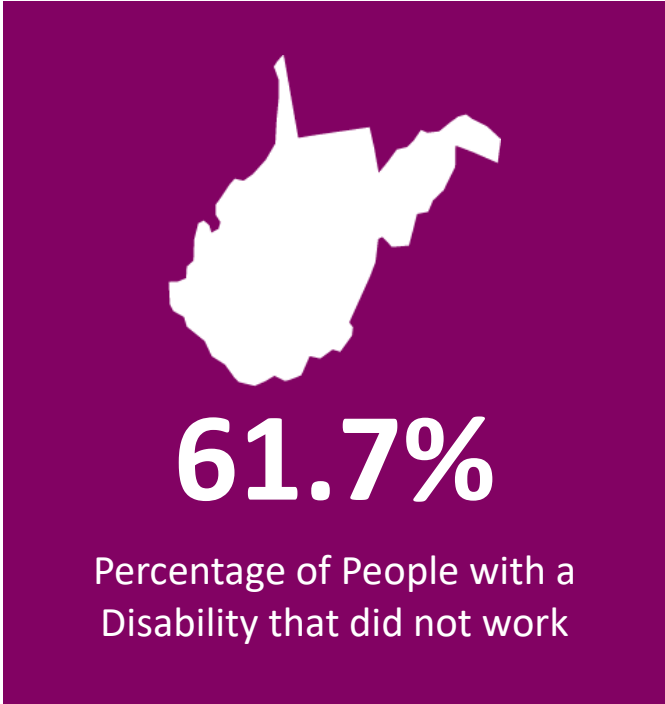

Working Age Population with a Disability (18-64): **178,229**

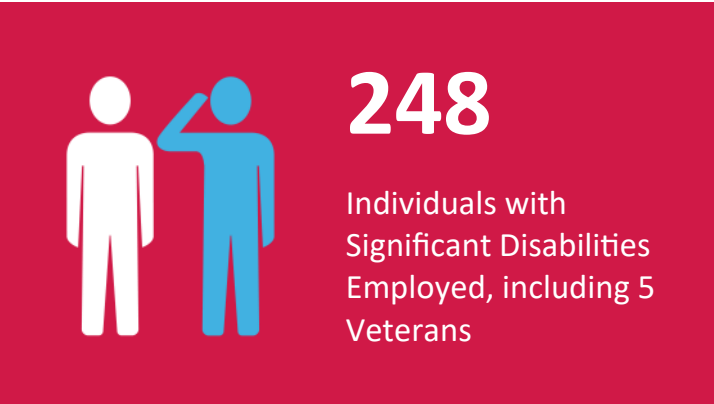

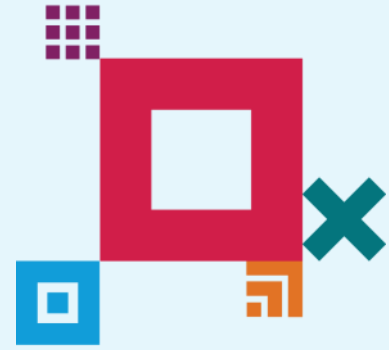
