

Follow these instructions for easy-to-build Grassroots Conference communications.

Aug 14 - 18:

- Familiarize yourself with the Grassroots Advocacy social media resources provided by SourceAmerica.
- Start brainstorming engaging and relevant social media content ideas that align with the conference hashtags.
- Start brainstorming a possible success story within your organization that shows employing people with disabilities can lead to good outcomes.

Aug 21 - 25:

- Begin planning your social media strategy for the Grassroots Advocacy Conference.
- Start building co-brandable social media posts using the Grassroots Advocacy social media resources.
- Schedule pre-conference posts using the provided sample posts for NPAs.
- Start drafting the success story within your organization that shows employing people with disabilities can lead to good outcomes.

Aug 28 - Sept 1:

- Draft relevant social media content ideas that align with the conference hashtags.
- Finalize your success story and post it on your website.
- Schedule social media posts to promote your success story with story links.

Sept 4 - 8:


